### In Loving Memory



Fr. Alexander Shahun, OMI 1929 - 2017

Father Alexander Shahun, OMI passed away on May 16, 2017 at the Grey Nuns Hospital, Edmonton, AB at the age of 96.

Fr. Edward Kosa, OMI celebrated a Funeral Mass on May 26, 2017 at St. Albert Parish; interment followed in the Oblate Plot of the St. Albert Catholic Cemetery

Father Alex was born in Regina, SK on October 19, 1920.

He was predeceased by his parents, Frank Shahun and Rita (ne Schwengler), and his sister, Margaret.

Father Shahun pronounced his First Vows with the Missionary Oblates of Mary Immaculate on September 8, 1941 and was ordained a priest on June 4, 1948 at St. Mary's Church, Regina, SK, by Bishop Michael O'Neill. . He professed his ministry in the following places: Allen, Battleford, Marsden, Scott, Lancer, and Saskatoon, SK; Fairview, Medicine Hat, Edmonton, and Calgary, AB. He retired at Foyer Lacombe in St. Albert, AB in 2010, and in December 2014 he moved to St. Thomas Health Centre, Edmonton, AB.

May he rest in peace.

# News from Kenya - by Fr. Alfred Groleau, Superior

At Eucharist this morning, I enjoyed the melodious voices of fourteen young African men on their journey to Oblate priesthood. They are studying Philosophy at the Consolata Institute of Philosophy in Nairobi. Three of them have completed their degree and they intend to proceed to Oblate novitiate in January. I leave this morning for Meru, a five-hour trip by public transit called mutatu, where I will be teaching ten postulants who have joined last January. On Sunday, all will gather for the final profession of Zachary who was a postulant in Meru when I came to Kenya in 2006.

Last night the community gathered to celebrate the closing of the academic year. We sat outside on the porch of the beautiful dining room that was still unfinished when I moved into this property in December 2006. At that time from this sight we used to view the Ngong hills that reminded me of Karen Blixen's words: "I once had a farm in Africa overlooking the Ngong hills. These hills have a round shape like knuckles from whence comes their name. Now they are hidden by the trees that have grown. Much has transpired in the past decade.
