Travel Notice

Please note that the CIBC convenience cards do not work for purchases outside of Canada, they can only be used to withdraw cash from an ATM (bank machine) which uses the PLUS system. The ATM should display the PLUS symbol for easy identification. We ask all Oblates who are travelling to make sure that they have a working credit card and also cash – in the appropriate currencies – in case there is no available ATM.

"But our Society has two "chief" aims, not just one, and I think these two goals go together, both in our lives and in our mission. First, Mission: "to work for the salvation of one's neighbour by dedicating itself to the ministry of preaching." Second, that is why the text continues: "... its chief aim also includes providing its members with the means necessary to practice the virtues of religion to which they are so strongly attracted...".

A reference to our Rules, even if in a more spiritual way, was made by Pope Francis when he met the members of the 36th General Chapter on October 7 last year. Among other things, he said: "Following the example of the Founder, may charity among you be your first rule of life, the premise of every apostolic action; and may zeal for the salvation of souls be a natural consequence of this fraternal charity."
