MEDICAL ASSISTANCE IN DYING, WORKSHOP / RETREAT

Fr. David Perrin will bring this workshop/retreat to Galilee, July 7-9. Entitled "Why the Catholic Church thinks the way it does," Fr. David hopes to provide a place position be explained in a simple for discussion and deeper understanding of the issue.

On June 17, 2016, the Government of Canada passed into law Bill C-14, approving medically assisted dying. The Catholic Church affirms and believes that the deliberate taking of a human life goes against the dignity of the human person and the belief that all human life is sacred. But why position?
