Walter took a cab to Central Haven, picked up Fr. Ron Zimmer and took him to an eye specialist appointment. I admire that dedication!
 - Fr. Richard Doll was in active ministry until a month ago. He recently gave marriage prep to my daughter and her future husband who got married at the beginning of December. I had heard that Fr. Richard was awesome with young people and even though he wasn't feeling great at the time he did a remarkable job with Ali and Matthew.
 - Fr. George Gruber, with his limited eyesight, assists with the sacrament of reconciliation.
 - Fr. Louis Hoffart says mass at the prison twice a month as well as doing replacement ministry.
