Fr. Alfred Groleau, OMI District Superior, will return to St. Albert from his summer visit to Kenya on September 12.


Fr. Frank Kuczera, OMI, who was staying at Vital Grandin Centre this summer, has returned to the US for his work with the Oblate Formation Program.
