

Prayerful Remembrance



Rev. Donald Douglas MacDonald, O.M.I., passed away on Sept 24, 2017 at Brock Fahrni Pavillion, Vancouver, BC. Fr. DD was born July 14, 1933 in Antigonish, NS. He was Ordained to the Priesthood in the Congregation of the Missionary Oblates of Mary Immaculate Dec. 19, 1959 in Antigonish, NS. Fr. DD is survived by two sisters: Phyllis (Ronald) McLeod of Connecticut, USA, Moira (Leonard) Prekel of Michigan, USA and a brother, Ronald (Myrna) MacDonald of Antigonish, NS. He is predeceased by his parents, Angus Ronald and Marie MacDonald (nee MacInnis), sister Annette MacDonald and brother, John R. MacDonald.

Following graduation from Morrison High School at age 16, he attended Saint Francis Xavier University in

Antigonish, NS and graduated in 1953 with a Bachelor of Arts degree. In 1954, Fr. DD spent a year at Saint Jerome's preparatory seminary in Kitchener, ON before entering the Oblates of Mary Immaculate in Arnprior, ON in 1955. He made his first vows as an Oblate on September 8, 1956 and perpetual vows on September 8, 1959. Fr. MacDonald was ordained at Saint Ninian's Cathedral in Antigonish, NS by Bishop Malcolm MacEachern.

Fr. MacDonald spent the next fifty years doing missionary work. While his first obedience was at St. Joseph's parish in Ottawa ON, he mostly ministered in the Province of British Columbia, including: Agassiz, Princeton, Penticton, Kamloops, Prince George, Fort St. James, Sechelt, Tofino, Kuper Island, Chemainus, Salt Spring/Gulf Islands and St. Augustine's parish in Vancouver BC. He also served briefly at Annunciation parish in Edmonton AB.

The past seven years, due to failing health, Father DD was resident at Brock Fahrni Pavilion in Vancouver BC. The Oblates wish to express their gratitude to the medical team and support staff at Brock Fahrni Pavilion for the love and care they gave to Fr. DD.

Fr. DD is remembered by his family, friends and Oblate family, as having a wonderful presence. He was compassionate, kind and caring. Fr. DD was very knowledgeable; he loved history and held a keen interest in politics all his life. He is also remembered as having a great sense of humour. He will be greatly missed by all who knew him.
