This is a traditional celebration for Oblates and it was also a welcoming one for many associates. For the first time in Brother Anthony District, we witnessed three year promises of Associates committed to OMI Lacombe Canada, some of whom have journeyed with us on a district level for many years prior. Also, there were nine professing their association for the first time.



What is it that has drawn them to share the inspiration of our charism? For some it was the last World Youth Day in Poland that helped them get to know the Oblates better. Some have worked intimately with us. either in Parish or Retreat Ministry, or, in particular, the Oblate Mission team. In one case the friendliness of an Oblate to the children with his dog led him to discover that "lens" through which he found the meaning of his Christian life. Certainly, the meetings of our provided BOCs а family ambiance that allowed for meaningful sharing as well as an



exposure to the life and charism of the founder. We are grateful to our local Associate animators and for the excellent resources developed by Sandra Prather that offers substance and structure for the initiation of new family members.

It was quite a celebration that we had: both fasting and feasting as we were superbly hosted by St. Albert Parish. We celebrated this Oblate Feast one day early out of convenience for our parish priests. During Lent, the parish offers the stations of the cross on Friday evenings; these were advanced to 6:00 pm because of our celebration. Intentionally and in good taste, the reflections for the stations were taken from St. Eugene and the Oblate Constitution. Oblate Associates led the prayer.

A good number of parishioners stayed for the Mass of thanksgiving and witnessed our renewal of vows and the commitments of our Associates: nine making promises for the first time and receiving our Oblate cross and many renewing for one or three years.



Other associates who could not attend will renew promises later at our Basic Oblate Community (BOC) meetings.

We are grateful particularly for the devotion of St. Albert parishioners shown in the warmth of their reception, for the leadership of Father Ignacy Warias, OMI and Serena Shaw, a member of St. Albert Parish staff and now a professed Oblate Associate. During Mass, Natalia Shrader shared an inspiring reflection on her experience in Assumption, Alberta in the 1980s when she and her husband Ed were shepherds of the Dene community. At BOC meetings this past year, Debbie Doornbos, Lucie Leduc and I have accompanied the candidates who made their profession this year and we know of at least two couples who wish to follow this journey in the coming year.
