- Responding to the call of the 36th General Chapter

- How can we as Oblate entities lead growth in this environment? The challenge is to grow in faith as we live this out.
- <u>Gifts</u> and <u>Fruits</u>- born of weakness \-born of generosity
- Renew focus on the poor and marginalized First Nations through the TRC / Abuse of innocents / Marginalized everywhere through options and possibilities
- Call for Leadership at the Provincial Level How to do this? Who is called?

- An approach to working with 1st Nations
- Settler place and the concept of ally
- Social Justice activity and the place of ally
 - o we understand but do not share risk
 - o we enjoy unearned advantage
 - o we use privilege to support risk
 - we offer sustained support
 - we provide continuous engagement
 - we are not to be a voice for the voiceless, but rather be an amplifier for their voice.
- They call you ally it is not ours to claim
- Allied theology for social movement to spiritual practice
- Scriptural reference: Exodus
 - o It is the women who resist (Puah and Shiphrah)
 - o Offer civil disobedience against an unethical call
 - Hero Origin story Moses vs Pharaoh
 - o Miriam, mom, baby (Miriam makes everything happen)
 - o Pharaoh's daughter understood her privilege
 - conspires to protect her privilege rather that to explicitly do what is right
 - Scriptural practice of ally-ship is mission critical
 - racism
 - difficult truth
 - corporate displacement
 - how to withdraw complicity how to withdraw consent
 - Stanley Boushie or the Tina Fontaine verdicts
 - There was a First Nations Royal Commission tabled in 1996 with 440 recommendations in a 20 year plan none of these were ever acted upon.
 - The TRC has 94 Calls to Action that offer solutions.
 - The Kinder-Morgan Pipeline is an unsettling current day issue.
- A call to Remember to Advocate to Learn to Understand the underlying doctrines
- Where is the ongoing Colonization occurring especially regarding land?
- What inspires? What gets our attention? Now what?

Then the Convocation membership worked to identify areas where we could actually act:

- cemetery question
- The work at St. Paul's University
- First Nations spirituality
- Unjust mining practices
- Our 11 symposiums in 2016 were very important.
- What do we do? How do we do it? Partnerships / Areas of greatest need / what is doable?

- Call To Actions:
 - #59: Educate ourselves Read the report
 - o #60: Develop formal, authentic educational courses specific to the TRC
 - Don't make decisions in FEAR.
 - o Risk a pregnancy.
 - o Resist the urge to cocoon.
 - St Eugene sent Oblates to Canada in 1841 knowing he would never see them again. That took guts.
