
for those of us there and for Neysa – I am sure St. Eugene was smiling in joy too.

He remains among us through the Holy Rule which he had left us, and God and the salvation of souls: it is the glorious testament of his enormous heart, and in observing it we will find all our strength."

1861 General Chapter: Joseph Fabre, who was elected to be St. Eugene's successor as which is the expression of his love for the Superior General, concluded the Chapter with the words above.
