**Dogs flunk medical exams** – submitted by Fr. Eugene Whyte

A pair of dogs trained to sniff out Clostridium difficile infections in a Canadian hospital have been retired after failing a performance review. The Michael Garron Hospital in Toronto recruited two dogs from a rescue centre to guard against C. difficile, a highly infectious bacterium that causes diarrhea.

Previous tests had shown good results using a single dog, but when Border Collie Chase and German Shepard Piper worked side by side, they often disagreed about which samples contained C. difficile and which did not. To make matters worse, they were easily distracted by the contents of patients' breakfast trays and "found it hard to pass a toilet without drinking out of it" according to a physician running the study.

On a happier note, Chase is now enjoying retirement, having been adopted by one of the hospital's pharmacists, reports STATS.
