19th, Liliane On Sunday, May McCallum dropped by to visit Fr. Gilles Gauthier, OMI; she had collaborated with him in building a core for the Native Pastoral Centre that was later moved into Sacred Heart Church of the First Peoples. This began in the mid eighties when Father Gilles had been assigned to work downtown with an open agenda. He succeeded in getting a classroom on the ground floor of Sacred Heart School where he would meet with small groups from the area of 97th Street.

At the time Father Maurice Joly, as Provincial of Alberta-Saskatchewan Province, had hired psychologists Claude Prefontaine and Marian McIntyre to offer training for skills in Church leadership. Liliane was one who attended these sessions faithfully. Monique Piché was also one of Father Gilles' associates at that time. When a certain core group was formed, they

moved into in hall rented from the Brick Warehouse and launched the Native Pastoral Centre. A community developed that celebrated Sunday Liturgy and other sacraments of initiation over a number of years until a community was formed that was ready to move into Sacred Heart Church. We know how the Church for First Peoples in Edmonton has grown over the years at Sacred Heart, but the foundation was laid by people like Father Gilles and Liliane. Lucienne Meek coordinated activities at the Native Pastoral Centre for a number of years, followed by many others.

Father Gilles celebrated his 87th birthday on May 16th and Liliane continues to attend at Sacred Heart Church of the First Peoples over the years.
