COMMUNITY DAYS, MAY 13-16, 2019!

For three days in May about 25 Oblates and Associates gathered at Galilee for our annual Community Days. Not summer weather, however, but warmth of spirit and a genuine enjoyment of the time together for sharing filled the Oak Room.

Community Days 2019 began with a half-day retreat, led by Joe Gunn, the new Executive Director of the Centre Oblat. He raised the concepts of charity and justice, and talked about how important – but often complicated – it is when we chose to move from acts of charity to social justice.

A large part of the agenda for the two and one-half days was devoted to members sharing their ministries.
