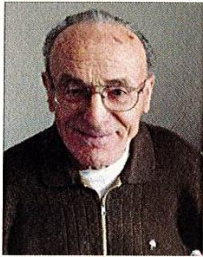

St. Charles Oblate Cemetery, Battleford, SK

Born in Belgium, Brother Oscar professed his First Vows as a Missionary Oblate of Mary Immaculate there in 1946 and made his Perpetual Vows in 1953. In 1957, he came to Canada as a missionary in the Archdiocese of Keewatin-The Pas, where he served until he moved to Mazenod Residence in 1996.

Brother Oscar's ministries were varied: he was a handyman, cook, gardener, musician, and provided many years of service within his religious and the wider community. At Mazenod Residence, he shared his gift of music, particularly by playing the organ at Mass, and gardening. In 2014, Brother Oscar moved to Trinity Manor with the Oblate community, and embraced his new living arrangements by participating in the many activities offered and was a regular at the cribbage table.

Brother Oscar was noted for his prayer life and piety. He had a particular devotion to praying the Way of the Cross, and to the Eucharist. Brother Oscar also loved classical music and enjoyed going to the symphony.

Brother Oscar is survived by his sister Judith Liebaert, of North Battleford, SK, and the Oblates of OMI Lacombe Canada, Saskatchewan District Community.

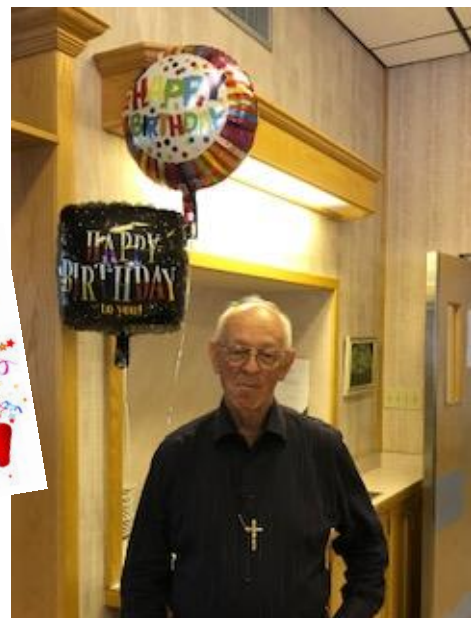

As we gear up for the fall, we are especially excited to invite you to join us in this year's 17<sup>th</sup> Annual Bike-A-Thon! Rock n' Roll with us on Sunday, September 22 and support the mission and ministry of Queen's House. Things will get underway at 9:30 am and last until about 2:00 pm.

### ***PARTICIPATION OPTIONS ARE AS FOLLOWS:***

**ROLL:** Join us for a beautiful bike ride in the country side! How to Participate: As a cyclist you can participate in this event by paying a \$100 entry fee. This fee is waived if you raise in excess of \$100 in sponsorship donations. We will be directed by Queen's House signage and accompanied by staff and volunteer hosts and a pilot vehicle.

- **Full Bike-A-Thon Route:** We will ride from Queen's House down Lorne Ave., along Highway 219 to Dakota Dunes and return back to Queen's House by this same route. This is a distance of about 55 kms.
- **Half Bike-A-Thon Route:** We will ride from Queen's House down Lorne Ave., along Highway 219 to a rest stop about 13 km south on 219 and back. This is a distance of about 30 kms.
