Mazenodian Family Monthly Oraison

February 14, 2021

"In prolonged silent prayer [...], we let ourselves be molded by the Lord, and find in him the inspiration of our conduct" (OMI Rule of Life, 33). The practice of Oraison was an important part of St. Eugene's daily prayer during which he entered into communion with the members of his missionary family. In this spirit let us become aware that we are praying in communion with members of the Mazenodian Family throughout the world.

Our Focus This Month

On February 17, 1826, Pope Leo XII approved the Oblate Rule of Life. With the Church's approval, St. Eugene de Mazenod recognized the hand of God in the life and spirit of his missionary family. Today the Mazenodian Family continues to recognize God's hand in how we live the charism and in the mission entrusted to us, which is expressed in the Rule approved by the Pope.

Word of God

In Deuteronomy 30:19, God's life was manifested in the Law: "I have set before you life and death, the blessing and the curse. Choose life, then, that you and your descendants may live, by loving the LORD, your God, obeying his voice, and holding fast to him.

The Rule is our way of living the Gospel. We can, therefore, echo the words of Peter in John 6:68: "Master, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life.")

Oblate Text

"Let us therefore, value these Rules as precious, let us ever keep them before our eyes, still more in our hearts: let us nourish our souls regularly with the principles contained in them, let us act., speak and think only in conformity with their spirit. It is only in this way that we can become what God expects of us and can become worthy of our sublime vocation... Hence what matters is that we be imbued with the spirit of our Rules and, to arrive at this, we must make them the topic of our regular meditations." (St. Eugene, retreat notes 1831)

Invitation to Pray

Meditatio (study): What does the text say to me, today, and to my life?
Contemplatio (reflect): What does the Lord inspire in my mind, heart and life? Sit silently with this question for a few minutes.
Oratio (state): What can I say to the Lord in response to this text?

Actio (act): How do I put this into action?

"The conclusion to be drawn from this, my dear friends and good brothers, is: we must work, with renewed ardor and still more total devotedness, to bring to God all the glory that stems from our efforts and, to the needy souls of our neighbours, salvation in all possible ways; we must attach ourselves heart and soul to our Rules and practice more exactly what they prescribe to us... In the name of God, let us be saints.

(Letter of Eugene to all Oblates, 18 February 1826, EO VII, n. 226)
