Fr. Richard Beaudette enjoyed an opportunity to have a visit with our very special Bishop Gerry Wiesner.


These two fine men worked side by side for many years while they did their Ministry in Prince George, BC.

A very big thank you to JoAnne Chrones & Brian Zimmer for always making sure we have delicious, homemade treats for our time together. We are a very lucky group indeed.






PRECIOUS MOMENTS
